• Dispatcher Recognition

• Motorola Support for Provisioning, Mapping, and Routing

Director Wilson reported on the current state of Mapping and Provisioning. While the MOU between St Louis County ECC and REJIS is being reviewed, REJIS is receiving map updates from them and are working on getting the needed changes into the system. This is a huge undertaking, but REJIS is working through it. Provisioning is and will always be a work in progress, but ECDC management is working with REJIS and a Motorola Subject Matter Expert to get through some of the more tedious aspects of provisioning. Board requested a list of outstanding issues that are currently being worked on.

Board requested that the REJIS GIS person come to the next meeting to present a short overview of what is being done. Board would also like a Q/A session after the presentation.

• Mission Critical Partners CAD/Staffing/Pricing Assessment

 Kick-off for the staffing study/pricing strategy was 13 Aug; kick-off for the on-site CAD assessment is set for 23-25 Sep.

Director Wilson reported that ECDC had an online meeting last month, meeting the MCP staff and discussed the onsite. MCP will be on site 23-25 September and that all partner agencies should watch for an email to schedule meetings with MCP staff.
